Coldstream Elementary School Parking Lot Safety

- Kids MUST use the crosswalk by the front entrance. This is for their safety. We are finding a lot of kids are crossing at the back between the cars. We've had a few near misses in the last couple of weeks!
- Two Drop and Go lanes 8:10-8:40am and 2:15-2:45pm: Please remain at your vehicle during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up. This is to ensure that traffic is flowing. When you see the car ahead of you leave or move forward, please follow and move forward so that your child can hop in/out nearest to the front of the pick-up/drop-off zone. We are working with our crossing guards to be quicker with morning crossing.
- If you are needing to get out of your vehicle to go into the school, please park in the main parking lot. You will notice on the map that the first two spots are RESERVED, these are reserved for school district staff as well as emergency vehicles (please do not park in those 2 spots)
- When exiting the parking lot please use the left lane for left hand turns and the right lane for right hand turns. Please make sure you are watching for students crossing Kalamalka Rd. as well as along the sidewalk that crosses the parking lot exit.
- Please do not block the bus lane! At times, this will mean that you will have to exit the
 parking lot and circle back around into the lot so that the bus has room to pull
 through.
- If everyone helps to keep the parking lot flowing safely and efficiently, it usually only takes 6-7 minutes to complete all pick-ups and drop-offs!
- Please ensure that anyone picking-up or dropping-off your child is aware of these procedures.
