

Elementary Basketball Rules of Play (Vernon School District #22) 2025 Season

Regular NCAA basketball rules will be used, with the following exceptions:

- Size 6 basketballs (28.5) for both girls and boys.
- Basket Height is 9 feet.
- All games will be 8 periods of 4-minute quarters, with stoppage of the clock only occurring during free throws.
- o One minute in between periods and 3 minutes at half time.
- Each team has two time-outs per game. One minute long. only after a made basket or a stoppage of play (whistle) - Free throws do not count.
- o Free Throws 5 in the line and the shooter

Court Rules:

- 1. Man-to-man defense is compulsory. Teams found to be playing zone defense will be warned once, then given a technical foul (2 shots and possession of the ball to the opposing team). **DOUBLE TEAMING of the ball by the defense outside of their defensive key is NOT ALLOWED.**
- 2. No 3 pointers. All shots are worth two points.
- **3.** Two foul shots are awarded for all shooting, intentional or technical fouls. All other fouls will result in possession of the ball for the opposing team (no bonus free throws).
- **4.** Free throws: we can line up 6 rebounders (2 offensive, and 4 defensive). All other non-shooting players are behind the jump circle.
- 5. When a team has a throw in anywhere in its back court, the defenders must fall back to half court. Defense can be played only after the ball crosses center.
- **6.** Once there is a clear change of possession (two hands on the ball or dribbling has begun) the defending team must retreat behind the half court line.
- 7. No center line on throw-ins. You can throw the ball back across the center line on a throw-in from the front court. However, once your team has possession of the ball in the front court, the ball cannot be dribbled or passed back across the line.
- **8.** A dribble is in the front court when both feet and the ball cross the line.
- 9. In all games during the regular season or tournaments, coaches are expected to play all players equal time or as fair as possible. Teams <u>MUST</u> adhere to this rule for entirety of the season moving forward, this includes playoffs and championships.
- 10. If you have two teams from the same school, for playoffs they will be placed in the same zone, and their first game is against each other.

Safety Rules:

- 1.Uniforms must be tucked in.
- 2. Athletic shorts
- 3. NO JEWELRY (No earrings, not even covered with tape)
- 4. Running Shoes and Socks

OVERTIME RULE:

In Final Games where teams are tied at the end of regulation time and a winner must be decided - an additional 4-minute period will be played.
